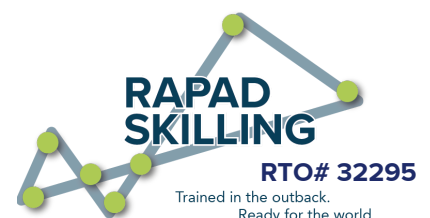

Course Structure

To achieve RII20720 Certificate II in Civil Construction, a total of 16 units of competency must be completed, comprising of 10 core units and 6 elective units. This course that will take between 12 -24 months depending on the learner and their individual circumstances. The trainer will assist in selecting the most appropriate units of competency to study based on the both the learner and employers desired outcome. Training is available in a variety of locations and can vary depending on the delivery mode selected. Our RAPAD Skilling trainers travel to the seven RAPAD council regions of Longreach, Winton, Barcaldine, Blackall-Tambo, Boulia, Diamantina, Barcoo and beyond.
